GOD Not a Fool In His Patience With YOU

atch it! You may not have openly said that God is a fool, but the way you have been responding to His patience has said so. Action is said, speaks louder than voice. You may ask: What action? Or how have I responded to God's patience? Know it that the non-repentant posture of your sinful life speaks against God's patience.

Let me ask you these questions. Have you ever given it a thought to give up your sinful lifestyle? Will you say that you are not a sinner? Does your heart not prick you as you get involved in sinful habits? When you continue in such pattern of life, you are already saying that God is a fool in his patience with you.

Let me tell you. God is patient with everyone for a reason. He knows what He will do to every non-repentant sinner. He will reveal His wrath some day. But, He is patient, giving enough opportunity to everyone to repent. He is patient with you, not wanting you to perish (see 2 Peter 3:9). This is God's loving patience revealed.

Dear reader, do you really understand what God's patience is saying to you? Just one clear truth, God's patience is saying: Repent, repent, repent and believe the gospel.

The gospel has power to save every sinner who believes it (see Romans 1:16). I can testify that I am one of the millions of souls the gospel has saved. And now I have peace with God (Romans 5:1).

Yes, you need to be saved from sin and Satan's dominion. Salvation is an all inclusive experience. The way to have this salvation is the way of the Cross, where Jesus triumphed over Satan and all his evil works (see Colossians 2:9-15).

I yield my heart to Jesus as my Lord and Saviour from sin. * O God, I plead for mercy and pardon of all my sins; Make me now your own dear child by Jesus death; Create in me a new heart to really love and obey you henceforth.
