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Read the above Scripture several times and let it sink down in you that God is seeing you whoever you may be (man or woman, boy or girl, rich or poor). He knows all about you as the source of your existence. He gives life and breath to all (see Acts 17:25). God is also seeing other things aside human beings in the world. In view of the fact that God is seeing you (my friend), what manner of life ought you to live in this world? Living carelessly or soberly? Sit back and take careful stock of your life. You are God's creature, so you are accountable to Him. What have you done with: time, talent, position and money given to you by God? What have you done with your body? Are you using your body for sexual sin (fornication, adultery, homosexuality,

bestiality, rape and sex-worker affair asewo), astral-travel and witchcraft? What have you done on your body; using it for tattoo, incision, charms and body-bleaching (in the name of make-up)? What have you done with your hands: armed or pen robbery, treasury looting, economic sabotage (oil pipe vandalism, smuggling), election rigging, yahoo-yahoo guy's activity, etc? Hey! You'll certainly give account to God. What account? It's an account of stewardship. Are you a good or a bad steward of every endowment God has deposited in you? Your arrogance will not stand before the sovereign God.

Friend, two things that can conveniently take place in your life are repentance and remission of sins (examine Luke 24:47, Acts 2:37f). Repentance is what you can do sincerely while remission of sins is what God can do for you when you repent genuinely. There is room for you to repent now if you have been living a prodigal life with God's abundant grace. In Luke 15:17ff, the prodigal son came to self realization and went to his father; confessing his unworthiness
